### **Parental vigilance**

We ask parents to take their child's temperature (if the child has flu symptoms) every morning and evening and to make sure that if the temperature is above 37.5 ° C, the child should stay at home. We need your help to detect any signs of fever as quickly as possible and report them to your regular doctor. Parents will notify the school in case of infection.

### **Access to school**

In order to minimize any contagious risk, only kindergarten parents are allowed to enter the school. If you need to go to the administration or accounting service, please ask the permission from the guard at the entrance.

### **Temperature measurement at school**

From February 23, the teachers or the BVS will take the temperature of any student with flu-like symptoms (runny nose, cough, sneezing, etc.). In the event of a positive result (2 measurements with an infrared thermometer) the student will be isolated (APE room) under the supervision of an adult and a mask will be given to him pending the arrival of a parent.

We apologize in advance for the inconvenience and possible delays that the implementation of these measures could cause in the first days. We need all of your support and cooperation to minimize the impacts.

### **Hydroalcoholic gels**

Gels should not replace hand washing.

When the level of hygiene must be at its maximum, such as today, we authorize the children of CP to the terminal to bring a hydroalcoholic gel.

Each class will have at their disposal a hydroalcoholic solution. A solution will also be available at the entrance to the canteen.

In kindergarten, awareness among teachers and assistants of basic hygiene rules was deepened with children. Hand washing with soap and water is reinforced. Parents will accompany their children to the toilets for hand washing before entering the class (wash at least 20s with soap and water).

**Hand washing (soap for kindergartens, hydroalcoholic gel or soap for others) will be carried out for all students and school staff before the first entry into the classrooms, upon return from recess and before going to the canteen.**

We will not provide hydroalcoholic gels to kindergarten students to avoid the risk of ingestion and not distract children's attention from the need for meticulous and regular hand washing.

### **Reinforcement of school cleaning and disinfection measures**

We have greatly increased the frequency of school cleaning and disinfection operations, emphasizing heavily used areas, door handles, switches, etc. Our cleaning products are specific: anti-bactericide and anti-virucide. Our canteen staff apply the same rules.

### **EFT service providers**

Our catering service provider has implemented, in addition to these measures, special measures such as taking the temperature of employees seconded to EFT.

### **Operation of the school restaurant**

In order to limit any risk of contagion, students will no longer have direct access to cutlery, cups and bread, which will be distributed by school restaurant staff. No more uncooked foods will be offered at the school restaurant on a temporary basis. At morning recess, only oranges will be distributed (contribution in vit C).

### **Recommendations to protect yourself or others**

We have put up posters at the entrances of the school recalling general hygiene recommendations.

### **A changing situation**

The measures in place today are likely to evolve to adapt to the situation. We thank you in advance for staying alert to all school communications on this subject.

We understand that the current situation is creating stress and worry. All the teams are mobilized to apply a benevolent and firm policy in order to control the risks and limit the impacts on the school's activities, without giving in to panic. We thank all members of the community for their cooperation in these complicated times. The health and safety of students continues to be at the heart of our priorities and to guide all of our actions.
